Rally Notes

Willis has a good course, running in northern Delaware and nearby Chester County with a finish at a nice park in the Centerville area. The after-rally picnic affords us a relaxed social atmosphere to enjoy. See flyer for details.

A second activity is a charity rally for United Way. Most have received a flyer announcing this. It is on Oct 10. Rich Stephani (longtime friend and sometime member of BMC) is in charge. I prechecked it about 3 weeks ago.

Last month I had mentioned my upcoming trip for two National events in LaCrosse, WI, a Course rally and a Tour rally. We finished 4th in Equipped class on the Course rally (nothing to brag about). On the Tour rally we missed entering a Pause on one leg, but ran the other 20 legs with 10 points. This would have been good enough for a win, but the missed Pause was a killing blow and we had to settle for a 3rd place finish.

After the LaCrosse events, my partner still needed 10 points to reach the magic 100 maximum for a share of the SCCA National Championship. (I reached the 100 point max at the end of June.) So we entered a South Jersey evening Tour event on Sept 18. Usually we have little competition on these events, but upon arriving we found another expert team entered as bigtime competition. We buckled down, and after the dust settled, we found we were winners (barely) with 5 points to our competitors' 6 points.

SCCA future activity for us is a pair of So Jersey Course/Tour events on Oct 16 & 17, then the SCCA year-end USRRC in Emmitsburg, MD on Oct 22 - 24. Contact me for info.
