BRANDYWINE MOTORSPORT CLUB and SJRSCCA present **MARCH LAMB XIV**. This event is sponsored by the rally cooperative consisting of the organizations listed above. The **MARCH LAMB** automobile road rally traverses roads through Cecil Co. MD, Chester Co., PA and New Castle Co., DE. Average speeds are at or below the posted limits. A challenge will be offered in most legs to correctly apply the rules of the rally (General Instructions/GIs). It is very important to pre-register in order to receive the GIs and prepare ahead of time. It is even more vitally important for this event since as a <u>Course Rally</u> event the correct course or timing is often determined by correct application of the GIs. We suggest that you visit the website (www.phillyscca.com) and review the tutorial regarding the T-Rule & Protection Rule (Identified as Lesson #1). A Tour Rally route is also provided using straight-forward instructions and combined classes using a handicap system.

## **Registration and Start:**

PARK-N-RIDE lot 1/2 mile north of Exit 1/ I-95 & State Route 896 in Newark, DE. at the intersection of SR 896 & SR 4.

## Finish:

Matilda's Restaurant, about 1/4 mile from the start location.

## Awards:

Top 25% in each class. Classes may be combined from SCCA E, L, S for trophy awards as defined in the General Instructions.

## **Participants:**

A minimum and maximum of two persons per car is allowed. Small children are excepted but all minors are required to have a Minor Release Form signed by <u>both</u> parents or guardian. (in advance)

## Classes & Other:

SCCA Classes E, L, S for Course and Tour Rallies.
An SOP Class (no calculating) is also offered for the Tour Rally only. Novice entries (neither participant having >10 events experience) should compete in SOP.
A sole entry in a class may result in combining classes. A \$5 weekend membership is required for all entries, unless both crew are SCCA members.

General Instructions will be e-mailed to all competitors whose pre-paid entry is received by March 20th. Advanced registration and receipt of General Instructions gives you the rules for the rally.
