Autocross Chair - Duke Wilford



As I write this, the temperature is 13°F in BMC land, and the autocross season seems very far away. Although spring will be here before we know it, BMC is facing some serious challenges for 2019.

Unfortunately, Dover Speedway has raised our rent by 40% from \$2500 to \$3500 per day. Autocross attendance has been trending down, and this additional cost will make it very difficult for the program to be financially viable. Raising our entry fees to \$55 means we need approximately 72 cars per event to break even, including rent, insurance, and overhead costs. This is well above our average attendance over the past several years.

I am currently working with a contact to secure at least a few dates at a different venue, but this may or may not work out. At this point, we need any and all suggestions in the northern half of Delaware or southeastern Pennsylvania areas, particularly if you have any contact information to share.
